**PRESS NOTE**

**Panchkula, 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2011:-** Sh. Dharam Vir, State Election Commissioner, Haryana informed that General Elections of Municipal Committees, Julana (Jind), Hathin (Palwal), Farukh Nagar (Gurgaon), Kanina, Ateli Mandi (Mahendergarh and Loharu (Bhiwani) are to be held in near future. For this purpose the Commission has issued Notification No.SEC/2ME/2012/40 dated 13.01.2012 for preparation of electoral rolls of these Municipalities. As per the Notification, the draft rolls shall be prepared on the basis of Assembly Electoral Rolls finally published on 05.01.2012 with reference to 1st January, 2012 as qualifying date. The claims and objections may be filed to the Revising Authority concerned by 03.02.2012 and the final electoral roll shall be published on 28.02.2012.

Dharam Vir further informed that the Deputy Commissioners have been directed that while preparing draft electoral rolls of these municipalities, it should be ensured that names of eligible persons, who have become eligible as on 01.01.2012 be included in the draft electoral rolls of the municipalities concerned. As per programme, the process for preparation of draft electoral rolls of these municipalities shall be started from 16.01.2012. The draft of the rolls shall be published on 24.01.2012 for inviting claims and objections. It is also further added that the concerned Deputy Commissioner have been directed to host the draft electoral rolls on the website of the district administration also. Any person can file claim and objection for including/ deleting his/ her name in the electoral rolls to the Revising Authority concerned by 03.02.2012 which shall be disposed off by the Revising Authority concerned by 08.02.2012. An appeal against the orders of the Revising Authority shall be filed with the Deputy Commissioner concerned by 13.02.2012 and the appellate authority shall dispose off the appeal by 23.02.2012. The final publication of electoral rolls of these municipalities shall be done on 28.02.2012.

The Deputy Commissioners concerned have been directed to set-up suitable number of internet enabled Voters Information and Collection Centres within the territorial limits of the Municipal Committee for the facilitation of the electors and the public to obtain information regarding electoral rolls and to file claims and objections. The prescribed forms can be collected from these Centres forthwith free of cost and can also be downloaded from the wet-site [secharyana.gov.nic.in](http://secharyana.gov.nic.in) of the State Election Commission and District Administration. The claims and objections can be filed at the Voter Information and Collection Centers. The Center would also issue receipt for having received claim and objections. They have also been directed to host the final electoral rolls on the website of the district administration, Dharam Vir added.
